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POTENTIAL HAZARDS:

• CV: palpitations, tachycardia, hypotension; with IV bolus: pallor, hypotension, weak pulse

• GI: anorexia, nausea, dry mouth

• Neuro: fever, drowsiness, dizziness, weakness, blurred vision, restlessness, paradoxical excitation (overdose) hallucinations, convulsions, death

- Renal: urinary retention
- Resp: chest tightness, thickened bronchial secretions, wheezing
- Local: flushing, pain at injection site; local necrosis with subcutaneous or intradermal administration
- Other: tingling of the hands; photosensitivity

CAUTION:

- patients with seizure disorders
- patients with glaucoma, urinary tract obstruction or peptic ulcer due to anticholinergic effects
- premature and term newborn infants

CONTRAINDICATIONS:

acute asthma exacerbations
