Audit - Income Verification for Subsidized Housing in Elderly Persons' Housing

PURPOSE:

To evaluate compliance to Southern Health-Santé Sud Elderly Persons' Housing (EPH) procedures and policies and Manitoba Housing subsidized eligibility criteria

PROCEDURE:

- 1. The Financial Analyst assigned to the respective EPH or designate conducts a random annual audit of a minimum of 25% of the subsidized unit tenant files to evaluate compliance with Southern Health-Santé Sud EPH policies and procedures and Manitoba Housing eligibility criteria for subsidized housing.
- 2. The results of the audit are documented within the "Audit Income Verification for Subsidized Housing in Elderly Persons' Housing" including recommendations to achieve compliance and follow up required.
- 3. The completed audits are forwarded to the respective Director of Health Services and a copy to the Executive Director.
- 4. The Director of Health Services will follow up on the recommendations.
- 5. The Director of Health Services is responsible to file audits and present same upon Manitoba Housing site inspection.
