


How to activate B. Braun Infusomat Pump Back to Prim - Manual "Call Back"


- You must set a primary prior to setting a secondary. For safety reasons please ensure you set your primary no faster than the rate of the secondary infusion.
- All secondary infusions will revert primary infusion and primary rate once secondary is complete. <u>This is not OK for 2 step infusions</u> (paclitaxel, docetaxel, rapid rituximab & obinutuzumab rapid infusion) to stop this process: Change all Oncology Pumps to "Manual Call Back":
 - 1. Program the PRIMary infusion
 - 2. From the Home Screen, scroll down to locate and select "SECondary"




3. Select "Back to PRIM -- automatic"



4. Answer "No" to prompt "Auto-Change to PRIMary?"



5. You have now activated the Back to Prim manual function



Note: The Back to Prim - manual function will remain active until changed by the end-user.

- To access the library step 2 of the 2-step process for paclitaxel, docetaxel, rapid rituximab & obinutuzumab rapid infusion you must go back and select a new secondary entry of step 2.
- By doing this once step 1 of above listed infusion is complete the pump will revert to a KVO rate and alarm until the Nurse re- programs the pump to the second step.



The KVO rate will never be faster than the infusion rate

KVO

- Rate -		
Rate >= 10 ml/h	5.00	ml/h
1 ml/h <= R < 10 ml/h	3.00	ml/h
Rate < 1 ml/h	0.10	ml/h
