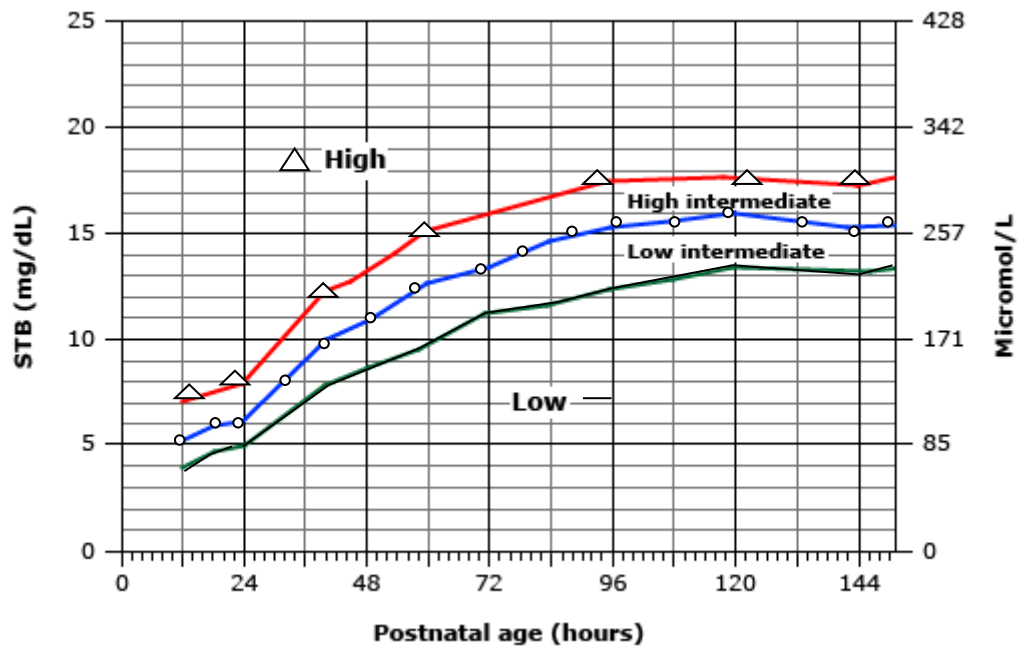


Bhutani Nomogram

Nomogram of hour-specific serum or plasma total bilirubin (TSB) concentration in healthy term and near-term newborns

The red \triangle , blue \circ , and green lines denote the 95th, 75th, and 40th percentiles, respectively. Risk zones are designated according to percentile: high (TSB \geq 95th), high intermediate (95th > TSB \geq 75th), low intermediate (75th > TSB \geq 40th), and low (TSB <40th). Infants with values in the high risk zone are at increased risk for the development of clinically significant hyperbilirubinemia requiring intervention.
