POLICY:

- 1. A boarder baby is a healthy baby accompanying a sick parent.
- 2. Boarder babies must not be admitted to the nursery, but will be admitted to the sick parent's room.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. The boarder baby will remain with the parent for the duration of the parent's admission.
- 2. Nursing staff shall be responsible for care and documentation of the boarder baby.
- 3. The health record will consist of the pink admission / separation form, the infant progress notes and discharge note.
- 4. If the boarder baby requires any medication and/or additional treatment, a change in diagnosis is required and the baby is no longer considered a boarder baby, but an admission.
