

CANNABIS EQUIVALENCY CHART AND ACTIVE INGREDIENT CONCENTRATIONS

Equivalency between Different Dosage Forms of Cannabis (Cannabis Act, Schedule 3):

Class of cannabis	Quantity that is equivalent to 1 g of dried cannabis
Dried cannabis	1 g
Fresh cannabis	5 g
Solids containing cannabis	15 g
Non-solids containing cannabis	70 g
Cannabis solid concentrates	0.25 g
Cannabis non-solid concentrates	0.25 g

Allowable Levels of THC in Consumer Products:

Product Description	Allowable THC Content
Natural health products	10 ppm (10 mcg per g) maximum; may not contain an isolated or concentrated phytocannabinoid
Industrial hemp	0.3% weight by weight in flowering heads and leaves
Cannabis oil	30 mg per mL oil
Unit serving of cannabis product (e.g. a packaged cannabis product)	10 mg
Discrete unit intended for oral, vaginal, or rectal administration	10 mg
Net weight of dried cannabis intended to be consumed by means of inhalation	Each discrete unit must not exceed 1 g dried cannabis

^{*}It is not permissible to sell cannabis products intended to be used in the human eye or that are administered by disrupting the skin barrier
