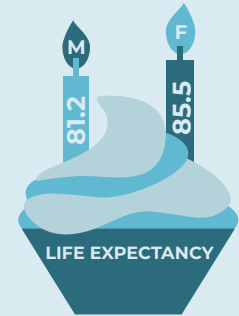

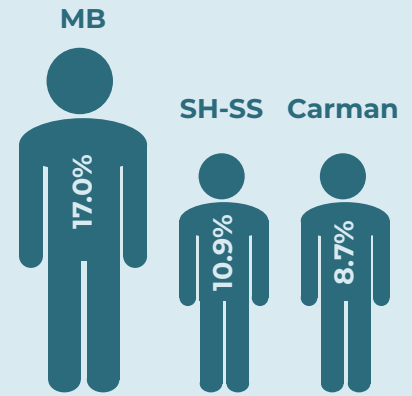

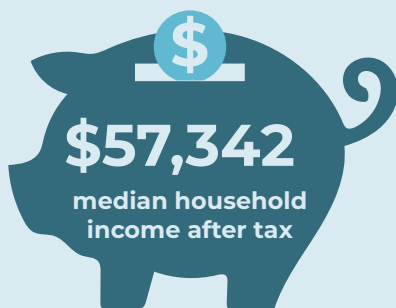

### DEPENDENCY RATIO

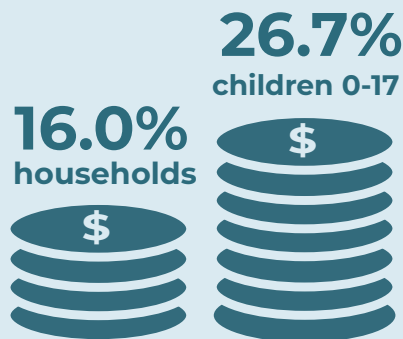
Carman had the highest ratio of youth (0-19) & older adults (65+) dependents to working age population (20-64) in the region, indicating more pressure on the working population to care for dependents

live in low income similar to the region & MB

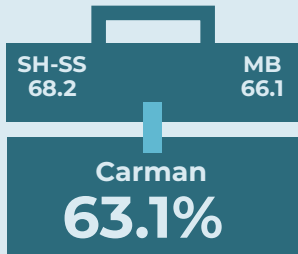


### HOUSING AFFORDABILITY

31% of tenants & 7% owners spend 30% + on shelter costs, similar to regional prevalence

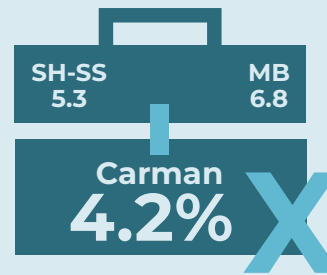

## LABOUR FORCE

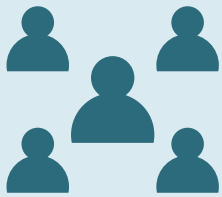


aged 15+ participate in labour force, more males vs. females

reflects status of family, workplace, & community relationships



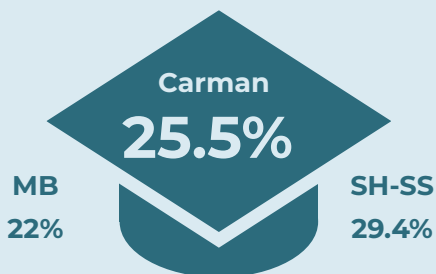
### MATERIAL DEPRIVATION

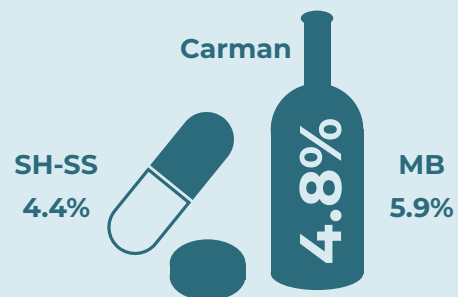

## EDUCATION



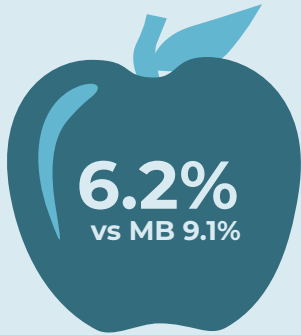
with no certificate, degree, diploma but the majority (46.9%) have postsecondary education

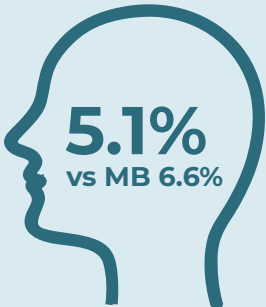


disorders lower vs. MB

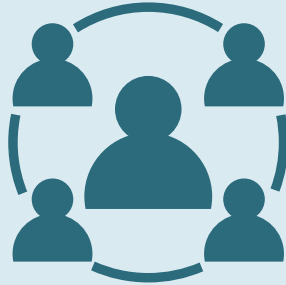

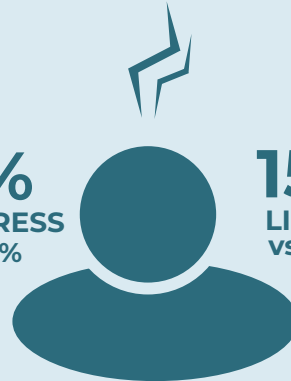
