PROCEDURE SUBJECT:

Cleaning Dryers

PURPOSE:

To maintain and clean dryers.

PROCEDURE:

Daily:

- 1. Clean lint traps.
 - Take cover off lint trap.
 - Pull lint trap screen out of the dryer if applicable.
 - Use a brush to brush the lint off the screen or vacuum the lint from the screen.
 - Place the lint into a garbage bag.
 - Seal the bag and dispose of in the garbage.
 - Check the screen for needed repairs and report to Maintenance.
 - Replace the screen in the lint trap.
 - Replace the cover on the lint trap.
 - · Document the cleaning.
- 2. Wipe all controls and surfaces with duster dampened with disinfectant cleaning

TEACHING POINTS:

 Follow the dryer manufacturer's specifications for how often the lint traps should be cleaned.
