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PROCEDURE SUBJECT:

Cleaning Equipment and Areas of Clean/Soiled Areas within the Laundry Department

PURPOSE:

To maintain the highest possible levels of "clean/disinfection" by following Infection Control Guidelines.

PROCEDURE:		TEACHING POINTS:
Da	ily:	
1.	Put on Protective Personal Equipment (PPE).	
2.	Damp dust all high touch surfaces and equipment daily, using a duster saturated with disinfectant cleaning solution.	Examples are washer and dryer handles, control buttons, sorting table, weigh scales, laundry baskets, light switches, etc.
3.	Empty waste container.	 Remove trash liners with both hands and hold the liner away from body. Clean waste container as required.
4.	Dry mop the floor.	
5.	Place wet floor sign by wash area.	Floor washing may be required to do more than once throughout the day.

6. Wet mop the floor using a wet mop and pail with a disinfectant cleaning solution.

Weekly:

- 1. High dusting completed and recorded as per facility schedule.
- Dust lights, ledges, frames, pipes in the department.
- Scrub floor using Autoscrubber as per facility schedule.
