PROCEDURE SUBJECT:

Cleaning Tubs/Showers

PURPOSE:

- To provide a clean environment for clients/residents.
- To enhance the visual appearance of the environment.
- > To prevent infections by cross contamination.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Use appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) according to Safety Data Sheets (SDS).
- 2. Prepare equipment.
- 3. Place the cart near the door so that the supplies are easily accessible. Ensure the cart is placed appropriately to reduce corridor obstruction.
- 4. Knock on the door and announce your services. Ensure the timing is appropriate to clean the room.
- 5. Clean and disinfect the entire shower or tub with appropriate solution, paying close attention to areas with soap scum build up.
- 6. If shower/tub has a mat, ensure it is scrubbed and hung up to dry.

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- 7. Ensure showerhead and taps are free of spots and mineral build up.
- 8. Change shower curtains as per facility schedule.
