PROCEDURE SUBJECT:

Cleaning of Hydrotherapy/Jetted Tub

PURPOSE:

To prevent the spread of infection.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Use Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) according to Safety Data Sheet (SDS), i.e. disposable gloves and protective eye wear if dispensing concentrated chemical.
- 2. Prepare equipment.
- 3. Clean and disinfect as per manufacturer's/chemical supplier's instructions.
- 4. Determine the necessary dilution of chemical needed for cleaning/disinfecting as per manufacturer's recommendations.
- 5. Please use the following guidelines to remove biofilm after each bather when cleaning tubs:

Jetted Tub

- 1. Fill tub with cool water up to water intake to completely submerge intake to prevent splashing.
- 2. Add chemical as per manufacturer's recommendations for disinfecting. Add defoamer if necessary, check SDS to ensure it is chemically compatible with disinfectant cleaner.

- 3. Place chair or stretcher inside of tub.
- 4. Circulate tub for 5 minutes.
- 5. Scrub/wipe all surfaces work for 5 minutes., chair, and stretcher with a disinfectant cleaner and allow to
- 6. Drain and rinse.
- 7. Fill tub to submerge intake with clear water to rinse the lines. Circulate for 1 minute.
- 8. Drain and rinse.

Hydrotherapy Tub

- 1. Fill tub with cool water enough to submerge equipment.
- 2. Add chemical as per manufacturer's recommendations for disinfecting.
- 3. Place chair or stretch inside of tub.
- 4. Scrub/wipe all surfaces, chair, and stretcher with a disinfectant cleaner and allow to work for 5 minutes.
- 5. Drain tub, and rinse entire tub, chair, and stretcher.
