PROCEDURE SUBJECT:

Cleaning of Stairwells

PURPOSE:

To provide a clean and sanitary environment.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Use appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) according to Safety Data Sheets (SDS).
- 2. Place the wet floor sign outside of stairwell at both top/bottom of the stairwell.
- 3. Place the cart close to the door to reduce corridor obstruction, but do not block entrance
- 4. Begin cleaning / disinfecting. Start at the top and work your way down to the bottom landing of the stairwell.
- 5. Damp dust door, spot clean walls, clean railings (top/bottom), glass and all ledges.
- 6. Remove any heavy soil / gum.
- 7. Vaccuum stairwell and matting and make sure the vacuum cord is kept to one side to prevent tripping.
- 8. Wet mop stairwell.

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9. Remove wet floor sign when the floor is completely dry.
