PROCEDURE SUBJECT:

Cleaning of an Occupied Isolation Room

PURPOSE:

To provide direction for all Southern Health-Santé Sud staff to follow and incorporate methods necessary to sustain the facility's environment at a level of sanitation and visual appearance, consistent with the Accreditation Standards, Infection Control and Manitoba Health Standards.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Use appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) according to Safety Data Sheet (SDS) Check for additional precaution signage on the room door Use PPE as indicated.
- 2. Prepare equipment. Make sure the housekeeping cart is fully stocked.
- 3. Perform hand hygiene.
- 4. Apply fresh gloves.
- 5. Follow the Isolation Precautions indicated on the room door.
- 6. Take minimal cleaning supplies into the room.
- 7. Toilet brush caddy/holder should be left in the client room for the duration of the client stay.
- 8. Proceed to clean as per procedure Cleaning of an Occupied Client/Resident Room ORG.1910.PR.018.
- 9. Collect garbage from receptacle when leaving the room. Ensure all garbage bags are tied firmly, and remain dry from the outside. Bagged garbage must be placed in the appropriate area.
- 10. Soiled cleaning cloths/Mop Head should be bagged and placed in the appropriate area.

- 11. Remove Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
- 12. Exit Room.
- 13. Perform hand hygiene.
