

Consent for Procedures, Treatments or Investigations List

A list of procedures, treatments or investigations requiring written consent:

ADULT AND PEDIATRICS

Anesthesia:

- Use of general/spinal/epidural anesthesia

Surgery:

- All surgical interventions performed under general/spinal/epidural and regional anesthesia and conscious sedation

All Clinical Programs:

- All interventions performed using procedural sedation

Renal:

- Hemodialysis (Consent may be for a series or for a single treatment)

Gastrointestinal:

- Endoscopy.

Cardiac:

- Cardioversion (non-emergent)
- Stress Tests that require physician supervision.

Hematology/Oncology:

- Bone Marrow Biopsy/ Aspirate.
- Chemotherapy
- Non-emergent blood, blood components and derivatives (Consent may be for a series or for a single treatment)

Respiratory:

- Bronchoscopy

Rheumatology:

- Needle Arthroscopy

Rehabilitation Medicine:

- Facet Joint Blocks

Diagnostic Imaging:

- Drainage of Abscess or Cyst Under Image Guidance
- Image Guided Biopsies
- Myelogram

Emergency:

- Blood sample requested by Police (Exception: As per The Blood Test Act)
- Sexual Assault Exam

Obstetrics/Gynecology/Reproductive Sciences:

- Chorionic Villi sampling
- Cordocentesis
- C-section
- Hysterosalpingogram
- Hysteroscopy
- Tubal Ligation
