

2nd Generation Infusomat® Space Infusion Pump Sets **Best Practices - Gravity Priming**

Preferred IV Bag Spiking Method


- 1. In a horizontal position, cradle IV solution container on your forearm with the hanger towards your elbow.
- 2. Hold the finger guard between your thumb and forefinger and insert spike straight into the set port.
- 3. Twist and push spike through diaphragm.

This method will:

- Minimize fluid disturbances
- Prevent spike from piercing the spike port
- Help to reduce air bubbles



DO NOT REMOVE Line Loading Guide



Preferred Method for Gravity Priming and Loading Infusomat Space Pump Set

- Use Aseptic Technique.
- Close roller clamp. Fully spike container and gently squeeze and release drip chamber until approximately 2/3 full.
- Vent cap on the drip chamber should remain in the closed position unless infusing from a solid stopper glass bottle.
- Slowly open lower roller clamp. Prime very slowly just past the first injection port; invert the Y-site. Pause; gently tap valve.

CAUTIONS: AVOID TAPPING OR STRETCHING THE SILICONE PUMP SEGMENT. PRIME SLOWLY TO PREVENT DEVELOPMENT OF EXCESSIVE BUBBLES.






- Close lower roller clamp. DO NOT reopen until instructed to do so by the pump. Ensure all air is expelled.
- Press (to power on pump.

Press (a) to open door 1.

Press (when prompted 2.



• Insert IV line from right to left starting with the two-hole clip 3. Line Loading Guide horizontal bar should be located above pump segment.



• Attach the white pronged clip. Ensure pump segment with Line Loading Guide is straight (stars are in a straight line)



• Insert the green anti-free flow clip 5 in opened green slot with hook facing down and outward. The safety clamp pinches the set 6.

NOTE: Flashing yellow triangle <u></u> in pump will go out when green anti-free flow clip is properly loaded. If <u>A</u> blinks, green clip is not properly installed.

CAUTION: Ensure there is no fluid flow in drip chamber. If drops are seen, close roller clamp and reload or replace set.





• Ensure tubing at each end of the pump is inserted into the tubing channels 7 8.



• Run finger along the IV set 9 from the green safety clamp to the white pronged clip to push the tubing into the air-in-line sensor.



Close the door by pressing firmly on each end 10 until you feel and hear a click.



Press OK to program an infusion 11.


Set Unloading

Preferred Method for Unloading Infusomat Space Pump Set

• Close the roller clamp **2**.

- Disconnect patient from the
- Open pump door. The clip catch will engage the hook on the green anti-free flow clip 13.
- Firmly press the green lever 14 to fully disengage the IV set and remove the set from right to left.
