Insulin Type	Therapeutically equivalent product within category / Prescriber Could Order
Rapid acting Insulin	<p>*Insulin Lispro (e.g. Humalog®, Admelog®)</p> <p>Insulin Aspart (e.g. Novorapid®, Trurapi®, Fiasp®, Kirsty®) - automatic substitution to Insulin Lispro 1:1 dose</p> <p>Insulin Glulisine (e.g. Apidra®) - use patients own or contact prescriber to change to lispro</p>
Short acting Insulin	<p>*Insulin regular (e.g. Humulin R®, Novolin Toronto®)</p>
Intermediate acting Insulin	<p>*Insulin NPH (e.g. Humulin® N, Novolin®ge NPH)</p>
Long acting Insulin (Products are not interchangeable)	<p>*Insulin glargine U 100 (e.g. Lantus®, Basaglar®, Semglee®)</p> <p>Insulin Degludec U-100</p> <p>Insulin detemir (e.g. Levemir®) - use patients own or contact prescriber to change to glargine</p>
