

# Inter MDR Transportation of Instrumentation Guide

### **Shipping and Receiving of Pre-Cleaned Instrumentation**

Shipping Facility: Transportation of Pre-Cleaned Instrumentation.

- 1. Manually clean all instrumentation obtained from OR and all in-house departments.
- 2. Using Inventory Transport Sheet, document all instrumentation to be sent for reprocessing.
- 3. Place pre-washed instrumentation into transport bags and seal with tape.
  - a. Do not overload each bag.
  - b. OR instrumentation remains separate from departmental instrumentation.
- 4. Place closed bags into biohazard transport bins.
- 5. Weight each bin and mark weight on the exterior of the transport bin.
  - a. Bins will remain less than 22lbs, when possible.
- 6. Place Inventory Transport Sheet into a plastic envelope and place in a biohazard transport bin.
- 7. Secure biohazard transport bin lid with zip ties.
- 8. Place filled biohazard transport bins and empty clean bins onto MDR dedicated transport cart.
- 9. Fill out regional shipping request form and secure to the exterior of a bin.
- 10. Leave MDR dedicated transport cart at designated pick-up zone for next scheduled courier.

### Receiving Facility: Receiving of Pre-Cleaned Instrumentation.

- 1. Obtain MDR dedicated transport cart from designated drop-off zone and transport to MDR.
- 2. Off-load biohazard transport bins into MDR Decontamination Room and proceed with reprocessing procedure.
- 3. Off-load clean transport bins outside MDR Assembly and Packaging Room.
- 4. Using a lint-free cloth and Oxivir, wipe the inside and outside of the transport bins and lids.



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### **Shipping and Receiving of Sterile Instrumentation**

Shipping Facility: Transportation of Sterile Instrumentation

- 1. Using Inventory Transport Sheet, obtain instrumentation on the list in preparation for packaging for transport
- 2. Place sterile instrumentation in Sterility Maintenance Cover and seal using self-seal strip
  - a. Do not overload each bag
  - b. Do not mix different departments instruments in the same Sterility Maintenance Cover
- 3. Place sealed bags into clean transport bins
- 4. Weight each bin and mark the weight on the exterior of the transport bina. Bins will remain less than 22lbs, when possible
- 5. Place Inventory Transport Sheet into a plastic envelope and place in clean transport bins
- 6. Secure clean transport bin lid with zip ties
- 7. Place filled clean transport bins and reprocessed empty biohazard transport bins onto MDR dedicated transport cart
- 8. Fill out reginal shipping request form and secure to the exterior of a bin
- 9. Transport MDR dedicated transport cart to designated pick-up zone for next scheduled courier

### **Receiving Facility: Receiving of Sterile Instrumentation**

- 1. At designated drop-off zone, unload sterile transport bins onto cleaned supply cart
- 2. Distribute sterile instrumentation to appropriate locations
- 3. Transport clean bins to MDR dedicated transport cart in the designated pick-up zone
- 4. Using lint-free cloth and Oxivir, wipe the inside and outside of the transport bins and lids
