Laundry Chemical Treatment Procedure

PURPOSE

To ensure staff have a guide for laundry chemical treatment.

PROCEDURE

Reminder: use gloves and protective gown when performing stain treatment. Use all chemicals on a well-ventilated area. Do not use spray bottles to dispense treatment chemicals onto fabric.

General Stain Remover - treats coffee, grass, most food stains

- Follow recommended instructions.
- Wash immediately after treating.

Rust & Blood Remover - treats rust and blood

- Follow recommended instructions.
- Wash immediately after treating.

Paint, Oil and Stain - treats grease, tape glue, lipstick & paint

- Follow recommended instructions.
- Tap stain /tape with small brush bristles to break up the fibres of the stain.
- Wash immediately after treating.
