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PROCEDURE SUBJECT:

Loading and Unloading Dryers

EQUIPMENT/SUPPLIES:

• Wheeled Laundry Cart with Backsaver Insert

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Push laundry cart with clean wet laundry to the dryer.
- 2. Open dryer door.
- 3. Lift the wet laundry into the dryer. Use caution and lift only the amount of weight you are comfortable lifting.
- 4. Close dryer door.
- 5. Set temperature on the dryer for the category of laundry. Refer to the department procedures for cycles and times.
- 6. Set the dryer timer for the appropriate amount of time.
- 7. Start the dryer.
- 8. When drying cycle is complete stop the dryer.
- 9. Open the door and check the laundry to make sure it is completely dry and properly cooled. Do not check the laundry until the drum has stopped.
- 10. Unload the dryer into a clean laundry cart with a spring insert. Use caution and lift only the amount of weight you are comfortable lifting.
- 11. Close the door of the dryer.
