## Management of a Reportable Medical Condition for Safe Operation of a Motor Vehicle Checklist

| REPORTING REQUIREMENT: ACCORDING TO MANITOBA HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ACT AS PER   | RESPONSIBILITY                |

| SECTION 157(1) STATES: A duly qualified medical practitioner or optometrist shall report to the registrar the name, address and disease or disability, or any significant change in a previously observed disease or disability, of any person attending upon the duly qualified medical practitioner or optometrist for examination or treatment who is the holder of a valid driver's licence and who, in the opinion of the duly qualified medical practitioner or optometrist, has a disease or disability that may be expected to interfere with the safe operation of a motor vehicle that may be operated with the class of licence or permit held by the person. | A physician/nurse practitioner determines that a patient has a disease or disability that may be expected to interfere with the safe operation of a motor vehicle.  | •                             |
| Physician/nurse practitioner asks and confirms with the patient if he/she holds a valid drivers licence.  | •                             |
