

## Management of a Sexually Transmitted and Blood-Borne Infection Checklist

| <b>REPORTING REQUIREMENT:</b> Manitoba's Public Health Act requires health care providers to report all individuals who have been diagnosed with, or are being treated for a sexually transmitted infection (STI) and/or blood-borne infection (STBBI), as well as the identity of all individuals who a confirmed case may have had contact with to transmit the infection.   | <b>RESPONSIBILITY</b>    |
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| <p>The form-<i>"MHSU 6781-Provider Report Form for Sexually Transmitted and Blood-Borne Infections (STBBI) and/or STI Treatment"</i> should be used:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>➤ To report all laboratory confirmed STBBIs and all identified contacts</li> <li>➤ To report any STI medications provided based on clinical indications (i.e. contacts of cases or individuals with clinical symptoms or signs) prior to a diagnosis being confirmed</li> <li>➤ To report any updates to syphilis treatment previously reported</li> <li>➤ To provide updated case and contact information if laboratory confirmation occurs after treatment is reported.</li> </ul> | Health Care Professional |

| <input type="checkbox"/> Upon completion, print the form and submit by secured fax or courier to the Manitoba Health Surveillance Unit (MHSU) within <b>five business days</b> of the interview with the case or treatment being provided.   | ⊙                        |
