

## Management of a Sexually Transmitted and Blood-Borne Infection Checklist

REPORTING REQUIREMENT: Manitoba's Public Health Act requires health care providers to	RESPONSIBILITY
report all individuals who have been diagnosed with, or are being treated for a sexually	
transmitted infection (STI) and/or blood-borne infection (STBBI), as well as the identity of all	
individuals who a confirmed case may have had contact with to transmit the infection.	<del>-</del>
<ul> <li>The form-"MHSU 6781-Provider Report Form for Sexually Transmitted and Blood-Borne Infections (STBBI) and/or STI Treatment should be used:         <ul> <li>To report all laboratory confirmed STBBIs and all identified contacts</li> <li>To report any STI medications provided based on clinical indications (i.e. contacts of cases or individuals with clinical symptoms or signs) prior to a diagnosis being confirmed</li> <li>To report any updates to syphilis treatment previously reported</li> <li>To provide updated case and contact information if laboratory confirmation occurs after treatment is reported.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>	Health Care Professional

All STI medications provided to patients should be reported on the "MHSU 6781-Provider Report Form for Sexually Transmitted and Blood-Borne Infections (STBBI) and/or STI Treatment". Public health will follow-up on confirmed cases and additional surveillance data collection.	•
