### PROCEDURE SUBJECT:

Operation of Carpet Extractor

# PURPOSE:

To provide a clean and sanitary environment.

#### PROCEDURE:

- 1. Use appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) according to the Safety Data Sheet (SDS).
- 2. Prepare equipment.
- 3. Place the wet floor sign outside of the room.
- 4. Move furniture as required.
- 5. Vacuum carpet or furniture.
- 6. Apply a stain remover as required.
- 7. Properly mix shampoo solution as per manufacturer's recommendations.
- 8. Hook up the hoses and cords.

- 9. Turn machine on (one switch at a time); first the vacuum pump, then the solution pump and the brush pump.
- 10. Shampoo carpeting, starting at one end of the room, work across the room, releasing solution on first pass. Make a second pass using the vacuum only. Excessively soiled carpet may require more than one pass. Best results occur when the carpet is shampooed in both directions and overlapped by 10%.
- 11. A fan may be used to speed up the drying process.
- 12. Return furniture to original position when carpet is dry.
- 13. Remove wet floor signs.
- 14. Empty dispensing and collecting tanks of the carpet extractor.
- 15. Flush clear water through machine.
- 16. Dry both tanks.
- 17. Wipe equipment and store in appropriate area.
