- 1. The maternal/child care services are based on the philosophy of South Eastman Health/Santé Sud-Est Inc.
- 2. Pregnancy is a state of health and childbirth is a normal physiological process.
- 3. Formal and informal education will assist the family in making informed decisions that will benefit them and the community.
- 4. The best possible care of the family throughout labour, delivery and the post partum period is provided by friendly, knowledgeable care providers through close observation, supervision and support.
- 5. The best possible care is provided to the infant by making frequent assessments and reporting events which could effect health and development.
- 6. Strong family relationships throughout the perinatal period are promoted by encouraging participation of all family members in the birthing experience.
- 7. Understanding, sensitive care is provided by recognizing each family's individual and unique spiritual and emotional needs and by respecting the rights of each individual family.
- 8. An interdisciplinary team approach provides for all aspects of the family's care which includes referral to appropriate community resources.
- 9. Maternal/child services should be family directed.

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
