Drugs	EPINEPHrine: three ampules (1 mg/mL) solution for IM injection	
Injection supplies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Six – 1 mL syringes</li> <li>• Six – filter needles for drawing EPINEPHrine from ampule</li> <li>• Six of each: 25-gauge needles 5/8 inch, 1 or 1.25 inch, and 1.5 inches</li> </ul>
