Status and Services

- 3. In provision of the Services, it is understood and agreed that the Contractor will not be subject to the control or direction of SH-SS as to the means and methods of performing the Services beyond basic requirements in provision of such Services and that the Contractor is acting as an independent contractor and shall not for any purpose be deemed to be an employee of SH-SS or to be entitled to any rights or benefits of SH-SS or its employees.
- 4. The Contractor agrees to provide the Services as more particularly set out in Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this Agreement.
- 5. The Contractor shall at his/her own expense ensure that all personal licensing and regulatory requirements, including Vulnerable Sector Search, Child Abuse Registry, Adult Abuse Registry and Criminal Record Checks are met for him/her to provide the Services.

Responsibilities of the Contractor

- 6. The Contractor shall ensure that the Services are being provided by a practitioner who has completed a Vulnerable Sector Search, Child Abuse Registry, Adult Abuse Registry and Criminal Record Checks. A copy of these will be provided to SH-SS along with credentialing information prior to commencing services with SH-SS.
 - 7. The Contractor shall pay all applicable government assessments including Workers' Compensation, Canada Pension Plan and Employment Insurance relating to him or her and the personnel employed by the Contractor.
 - 8. The Contractor agrees to indemnify and safe harmless SH-SS from any and all claims, demands or causes of action under the *Income Tax Act* or any other statue for or in respect of any obligation on the part of SH-SS to make contributions, withhold and remit any monies or to make deductions from its fee payments or in respect of any related interest or penalties, should the Contractor fail to make any such remittances or should it become deemed or considered that the Contractor is an employee of SH-SH.

- As an independent Contractor, the Contractor is responsible for his or her own Workers' Compensation coverage. SH-SS is not responsible for the Contractor's Workers' Compensation coverage.
- 10. It is understood and agreed that neither the Contractor nor any personnel employed by the Contractor are covered under the Liability Insurance carried by SH-SS.

Termination of Agreement

11. Either party may terminate this Agreement immediately and without prior notice in the event of the failure of the other Party to comply with any provision of this Agreement. Either Party may otherwise terminate this Agreement on the giving of thirty days' written notice.

Confidential Information

- 12. The Contractor acknowledges that pursuant to providing the Services, the Contractor will come into possession of confidential information and documents belonging to SH-SS and its clients, patients and residents. The Contractor covenants to keep all such information and documents strictly confidential and further agrees to deliver any confidential documents in the possession of the Contractor or any personnel employed by the Contractor to an authorized representative of SH-SS upon demand. The Contractor acknowledges and agrees that the covenants contained in this paragraph shall survive the termination for any reason of this Agreement.
- 13. The Contractor specifically acknowledges his/her obligation to comply with *The Personal Health Information Act* ("PHIA") and *The Freedom of Information and Privacy Protection Act* ("FIPPA") and acknowledges that he/she is a Trustee as defined by PHIA. Further, the Contractor agrees that while files, records and notes remain the property of the Contractor, the Contractor shall provide copies of same to SH-SS.
