# PROCEDURE SUBJECT:

Stain Treatment.

## PURPOSE:

To treat linen and personal clothes for stain removal.

## EQUIPMENT/SUPPLIES:

- Chemical stain remover
- Stiff brush
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Chemical resistant gloves, chemical resistant apron.

### PROCEDURE:

- 1. Ensure PPE is applied as per the Safety Data Sheet (SDS).
- 2. Lay out the linen article to expose the stained area.
- 3. Apply the appropriate chemical treatment as noted below:
  - <u>Treatment Enzyme 2</u> general stain remover
    - treats coffee, grass, most food stains
  - Rust & Tannin Remover
    - rust and blood
  - <u>P.O.S.</u>
    - o removes grease, tape glue, lipstick & paint.
  - Stain Blaster Enzyme
    - treats coffee, grass, most food stains
- 4. Apply using dispenser on bottle.
- 5. Allow to sit as per manufacturers recommendations.
- 6. Tap the stain or tape with small brush bristles to break up the fibres of the stain or tape. If able, remove the tape prior to washing.
- 7. Wash as per manufacturers recommendations.

### TEACHING POINTS:

- Use all chemicals in a well-ventilated area.
- Do not use spray bottles to dispense treatment chemicals onto fabric.
