PROCEDURE SUBJECT:

Stained Linen/Clothing Treatment and Rewash

PURPOSE:

To remove stains from clean linen and clothing that has been through the wash process.

PROCEDURE:

Any stained linen should be treated and rewashed.

1. These items should be placed into a cart and identified as 'rewash'.
2. Process using the rewash cycle set up in the washer.
3. Follow procedure for Operating washers
4. After the load is dried, any remaining stained items can be sent to be treated for stain treatment.
5. Put on Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). Consult the Safety Data Sheet (SDS) for appropriate PPE.
6. Spread article with the stain out on the table, with the stain visible.
7. Use the appropriate chemical to treat the stain following the directions on the label of the chemical.

8. Place the treated article into the appropriate cart.
9. Once the treatment of the stained linen is completed. Load the ‘treatment’ into the washer and wash using the designated formula and wash cycle. Unless specified by the directions on the treatment chemical, treated laundry should be washed as soon as treated.
10. After the load is dried any remaining stained items should be;
 - Marked as treated and continue to use
 - Discard and record as the same.
 - Clients will be notified if the stain is not able to be removed from personal client owned clothing
