

Transport of Hazardous Medications by Delivery Services – Driver Safety Pamphlet

What are hazardous medications?

Hazardous medications are drugs known or suspected to cause adverse health effects from exposure. These drugs include those used for cancer chemotherapy, antiviral drugs, hormones, some bioengineered drugs and other miscellaneous drugs.

How do I handle this package?

The hazardous medications you are transporting have been packaged appropriately to prevent any exposure risk.

- Handle with care
- The package should not be shaken, dropped or handled roughly
- Ensure the package is not exposed to extreme temperatures
- Please follow any site-specific handling instructions that are provided to you
