## PROCEDURE SUBJECT:

Transporting Laundry and Linen with a Lift/Vehicle

## PURPOSE:

To provide instruction for staff on the safe transporting of laundry/linen using a lift/vehicle.

PROCE	EDURE:	TEACHING POINTS:
1.	Put on Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) as required.	
2.	Ensure soiled laundry has been placed into closed laundry bags.	<ul> <li>Ensure all strings are tucked into the laundry bag.</li> </ul>
3.	Ensure all laundry/linen is contained in a cart.	Use safe lifting techniques.
4.	Push laundry/linen cart to the truck.	<ul> <li>Generally pushing loads is easier on</li> </ul>
5.	Lower lift from the vehicle to the ground/dock.	<ul><li>backs, arms and shoulder than pulling.</li><li>Keep other employees or persons away</li></ul>
6.	Push soiled laundry cart onto truck lift. Apply brakes as	from the lift when it is operation.
_	required.	Refer to lift weight limits on vehicle
7.	Operate the Lift to raise the soiled laundry/linen cart into the box of the vehicle.	<ul> <li>Make sure the load is secure on the lift before lifting.</li> </ul>
8.	Secure load in the box of the laundry truck.	
9.	Close door on the truck and	

secure the lift.

- 10. Transport the soiled laundry/linen to the laundry facility.
- 11. Open the back door of the vehicle and make sure the unloading area is clear and unobstructed.
- 12. Engage the lift and raise it to the vehicle box.
- Un-secure the laundry carts in the vehicle box and push the cart onto the lift. Applying brakes as required.
- 14. Secure the cart on the lift.
- 15. Lower the lift to the dock or ground level.
- 16. Pull the cart off the lift taking care not to tip the cart.
- 17. Push the cart to the appropriate storage area of the laundry facility.
- Close the door of the truck and return the truck lift to the secure position.
- **19.** Truck box should be cleaned after transporting soiled laundry.
- EQUIPMENT/SUPPLIES:
  - Laundry bags
  - Cart for transportation of laundry/linen bags
  - Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)
  - Truck with lift

- Use cargo straps to secure the carts from moving within the box of the vehicle during transport.
- Keep other employees or persons away from the lift when it is in operation.

• The cart can be secured from moving with caster locks or a railing on the lift itself. If the cart should tip, step back and let it fall. Do not risk injury by trying to 'catch' the cart.
