PROCEDURE SUBJECT:

Weighing Soiled Laundry

PURPOSE:

To efficiently process laundry in a cost effective manner. To ensure accurate loading of machinery and accurate billings for chemical supplies and/or contract laundry.

PROCEDURE:

Large floor scale

- 1. Determine the type of laundry to be weighed.
- **2.** Determine the size of cart and the weight required for the load.
- 3. Place the laundry cart on the scale.
- 4. Set the scale to display the 'Tare' weight.
- 5. Place soiled laundry into the cart until the desired weight is reached.
- 6. If using split pocket washer the load must be divided equally into two separate carts or 'sides'.
- 7. If using an open pocket washer the entire load can be placed in one cart.
- 8. Record the weight in the appropriate area.
- 9. Place the weighed load in the

TEACHING POINTS:

 Follow department procedures to determine the weight required for each specific type of laundry.

- A blanket or sheet can be used to show the division of weight for a split pocket washer when one cart is used to hold the entire load.
- Follow department procedures to determine the weight required for each specific type of laundry.

- appropriate area to wait loading into the washer.
- 10. At the end of the day the scale should be swept/ left clean for the next day.

Small cart scale

- 1. Determine the type of soiled laundry to be weighed.
- 2. Determine the weight required for the load.
- 3. Fill the scale cart with soiled laundry until the desired weight is reached.
- 4. Record the weight in the appropriate area.
- 5. Place the load in the appropriate area to wait loading into the washer.
- **6.** At the end of the day the scale cart should be cleaned.

Weighing contract laundry for billing purposes (before sorting)

- 1. Place the loaded laundry cart on the scale.
- 2. Enter the weight of the cart and press tare.
- **3.** Record the weight in the appropriate area.
