PROCEDURE SUBJECT:

Window Washing Using a Gasoline Powered Pressure Washer

PURPOSE:

To safely power wash windows using a Gasoline Powered Pressure Washer.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Use appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) according to Safety Data Sheet (SDS).
- 2. Prepare equipment.
- 3. Check gas and oil levels on unit as applicable.
- 4. If refueling is necessary, follow manufacturer's instructions.
- 5. Connect the pressure washer to the water supply with the garden hose.
- 6. Ensure connections are tight.
- 7. Do a check for people in close proximity to your work area.
- 8. Put on safety glasses and hearing protection.
- 9. Turn on the unit and spray the entire window paying close attention the frame.
- 10. Be sure to direct spray only at your work area and be careful of spray deflecting back on you.
- 11. Turn off the unit. Disconnect the water hose and drain the unit.
- 12. Clean Gasoline Pressure Washer and store in appropriate area.
- 13. Wipe down pressure washer, cords and hoses.
