PROCEDURE SUBJECT:

Window Washing using an Electric Powered Pressure Washer

PURPOSE:

To safely power wash windows using an Electrically Powered Pressure Washer.

PROCEDURE:

- 1. Use appropriate Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) according to Safety Data Sheet (SDS).
- 2. Prepare equipment.
- 3. Connect the pressure washer to the water supply with the garden hose.
- 4. Ensure connections are tight.
- 5. Connect the electrical cord to the closest electrical outlet.
- 6. Check the cord and make sure it is free from any nicks or tears.
- 7. Cord must have a ground connection and be plugged into a grounded outlet.
- 8. Check for people in close proximity to your work area.
- 9. Put on safety glasses and hearing protection.
- 10. Turn on the unit and spray the entire window paying close attention the frame.
- 11. Be sure to direct spray only at your work area and be careful of spray deflecting back on you.
- 12. Turn off the unit. Disconnect the electrical connection and the water hose and drain the unit.
- 13. Clean Electric Pressure Washer and store in appropriate area.
