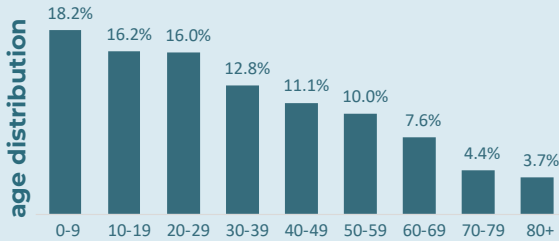


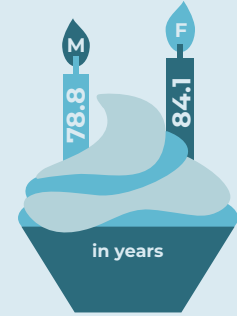

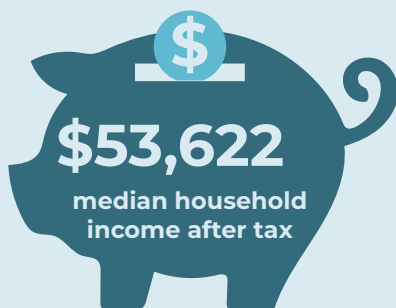

DEPENDENCY RATIO

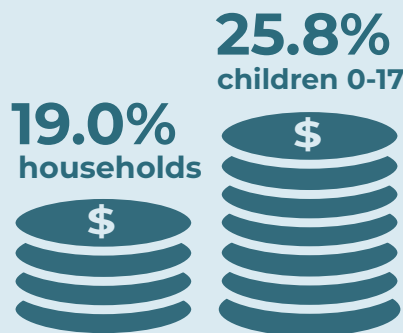
Ratio of youth (0-19) & older adults (65+) dependents to working age population (20-64), reflecting pressure on the working population to care for dependents

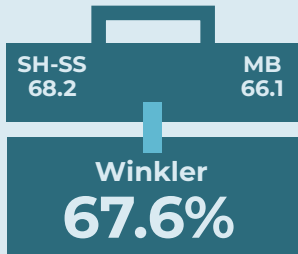


HOUSING AFFORDABILITY

35% of tenants and 12% of owners spending 30% + on shelter costs

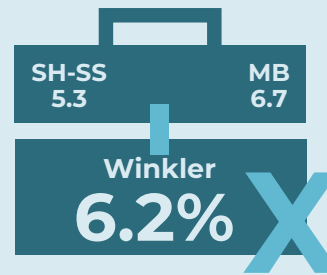

LABOUR FORCE

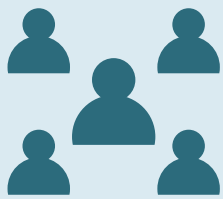


aged 15+ participate in labour force, more males vs. females

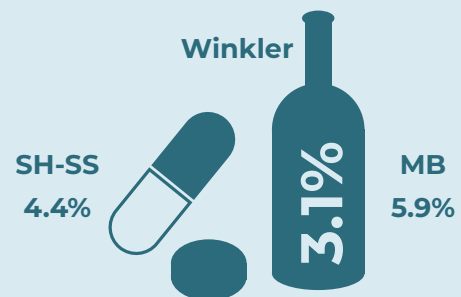

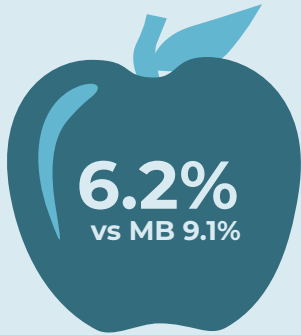

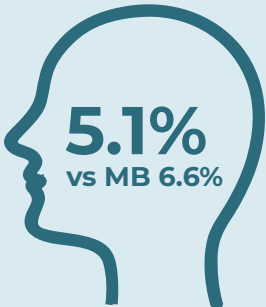

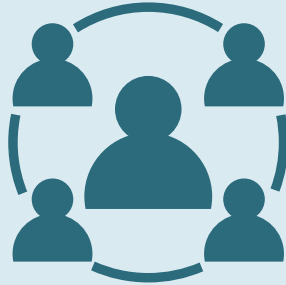

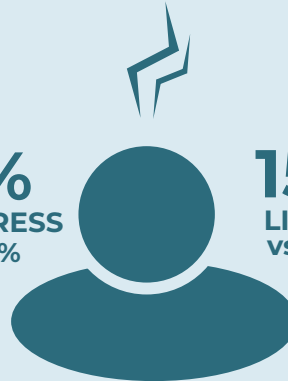
